# ACCME GUIDELINES RELATED TO THE SEPARATION OF PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES FROM EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

In compliance with the ACCME Standards for Commercial Support, all exhibiting companies must abide by the following:

- Exhibit and other promotional fees shall be separate and distinct from educational grants/commercial support.
- All exhibitors must be in a virtual room or area separate from the education and the exhibits must not interfere, or in any way compete with the learning experience prior to, during, or immediately after the activity.
- All promotional activities including interviews, demonstrations, and the distribution of literature or samples must be made within the exhibitor's space only. Canvassing or distributing promotional materials outside the exhibitor's rented virtual exhibit space is not permitted.
- Company representatives may attend educational sessions at MAHEC's discretion. However, representatives must refrain from holding any commercial discussions in the educational sessions, or through chats.
- Monitoring—the separation of promotional materials and activities from the educational area is strictly enforced throughout the activity by MAHEC's staff.
